Norwich based charity The Hebron Trust, is celebrating after being awarded £5000 worth of funding from The Screwfix Foundation.

Emma Pawsey from Hebron Trust said: "We are very grateful to The Screwfix Foundation for donating these much-needed funds to support our charity. With annual cuts to residential rehab funding, donations from organisations like the Screwfix Foundation are vital to us being able to continue to offer the care we do to women suffering from drug and alcohol addictions.

"The funding will be used to replace and relocate our water tank that has leaked in our loft causing damage through our house. Without the Screwfix Foundation we would have to keep repairing the tank putting us at risk of further damage. We'd like to thank everyone who was involved in the fundraising – it's been a great help to us," he added.

Hayley Good, Screwfix Norwich - Barker Street Store Manager, said: "We're so happy that one of our local charities has been awarded funding by The Screwfix Foundation.

"Screwfix customers are the driving force behind the Foundation, and without their generous

donations, it wouldn't be possible to support so many charities like The Hebron Trust.
